Introduction

The middle and the highschool la Joliverie are located in the heart of the Ile de Nantes, and in Saint-Sébastien-Sur-Loire (not far!). They have been awarded with the "Ouverture Internationale" and "Euroscol" labels for the school. This commitment underlines the school's determination to offer every pupil the opportunity to discover the international world from an early age.

The middle school is for young people aged 12 to 15. The highschool is for people from 15 to 22 years old. They propose professionals and general teaching in different field (mode, arts, woodmakers, technologic and numerics...) Each year, some students have the opportunities to do a workplacement abroad.

Service Civique

What is the Service Civique?

Le Service Civique is a french program for young people (usually aged 16 to 25) to engage in public interest missions, such as education, environment, or solidarity, for a period of 6 to 12 months.

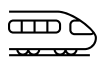
What expenses are covered?

- **Travel expenses:** not covered
- The **monthly allowance:** 619/month, (Regardless of which city in France you choose)
- For the **insurance**, you will have access to French National Health Insurance
-
- A French financial support to help cover **rent costs** (called Caisse d'allocation familiale) around 200€/month.
- We will also help you with all the **administrative processes** (insurance, bank account, etc.) once you are here!
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- Speaking French is **not** a requirement. It will be considered as an advantage, but no worries if you cannot speak it yet

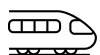

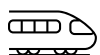
If you need to travel, in Nantes there is a trainstation from where you can reach a lot of cities, for example :



Paris : around 4 hours, 2 hours with the TGV



Bordeaux : around 4 hours



Sea coast : around 1 hour

Your accommodation

Your accommodation will be in the high school directly. You could share the kitchen and the bathroom with a other volunteer outside of the project.

You will have your own bedroom with all necessary inside.

In your private room you will have everything you need.
If something isn't provided, the PLM team will do their best to help you.
